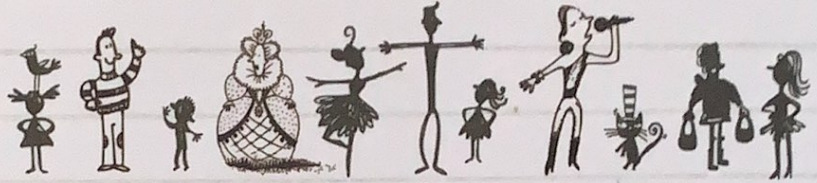


# Making up a character
